A Christian Girl Uses Her Talents for the Glory of God

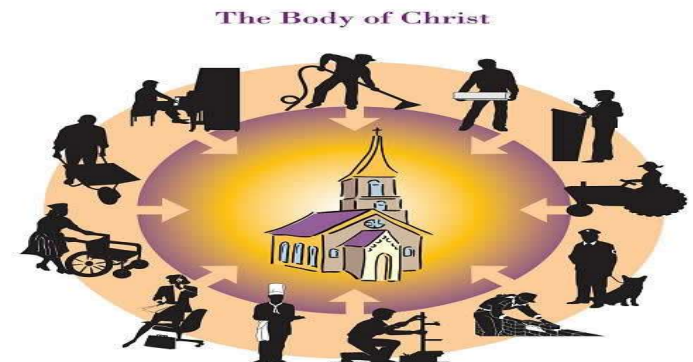


- God gave each of us talents.
