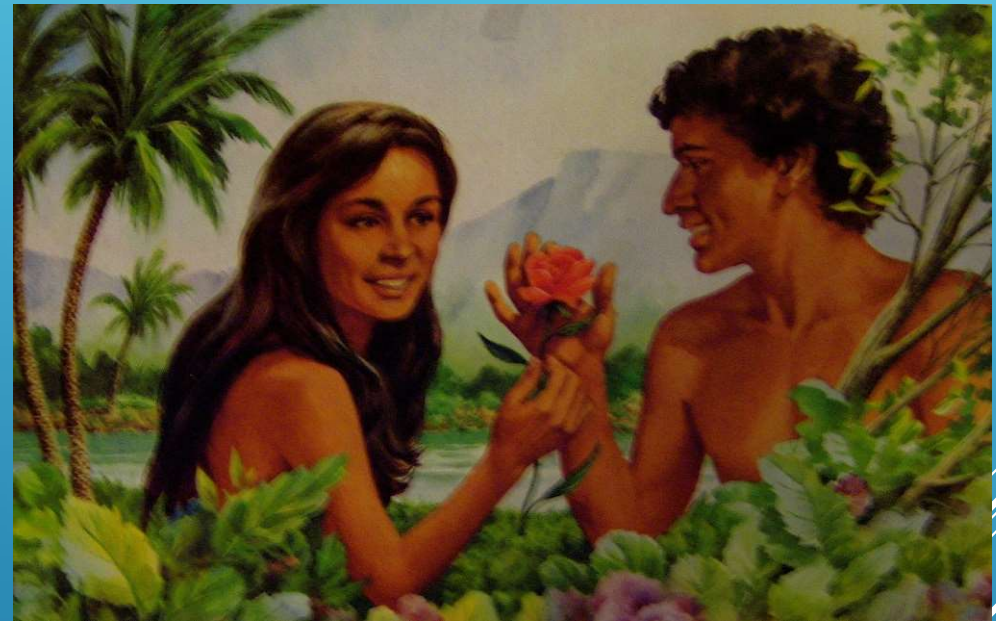
THE CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

THE CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

Some commentators have noticed that Eve was not taken from Adam's head so that she would not be above him; she was not taken from his feet so that he would treat her below himself; but rather, from his side, to complement, help, and be one person with him, serving the Lord together.

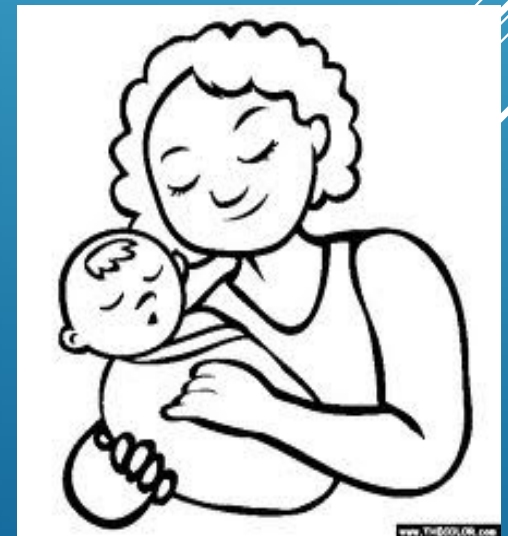


THE CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

Wife: Is called to nurture and care for the children and must honor and respect her husband

THE CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

Christian Marriage

- Marriage is one of the seven sacraments.
- It is called Holy Matrimony
- Must be in God's presence through the priest (who represents God)

THE CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE
